Pig Flew



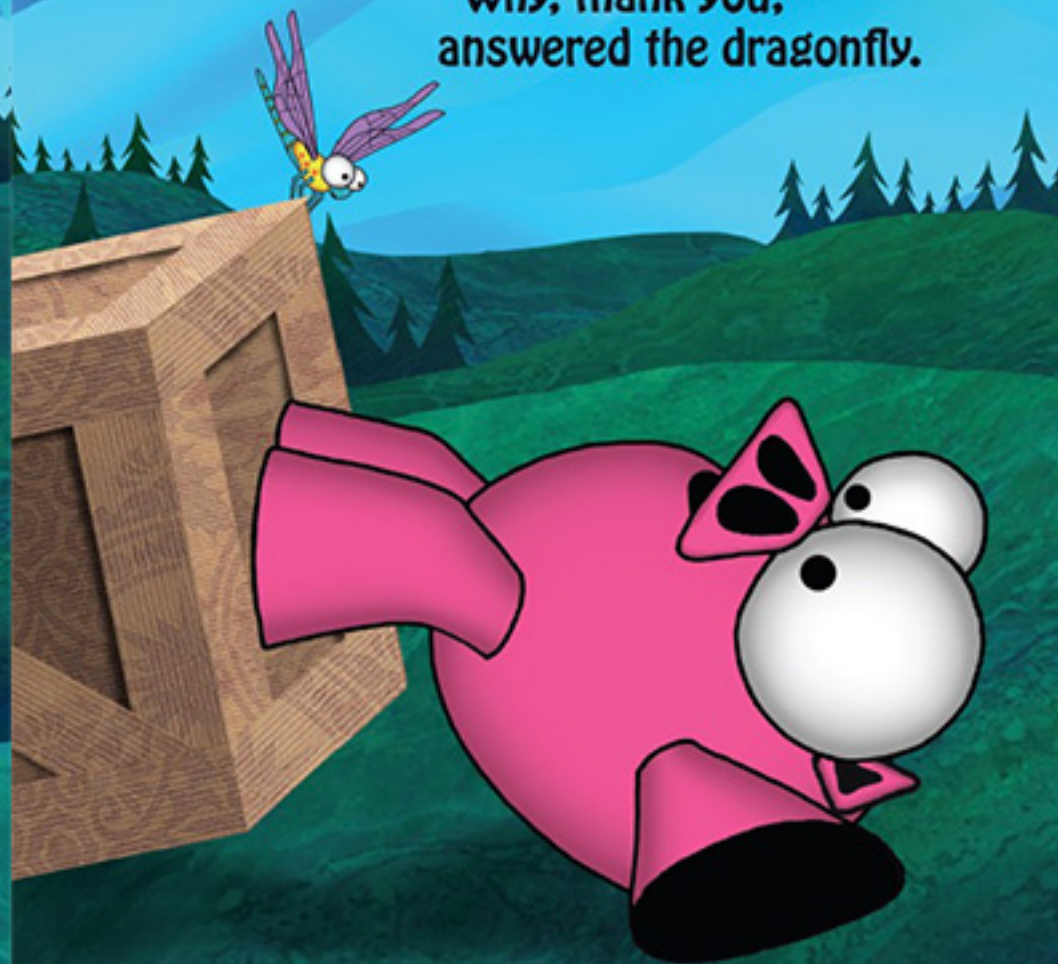

answered the dragonfly.



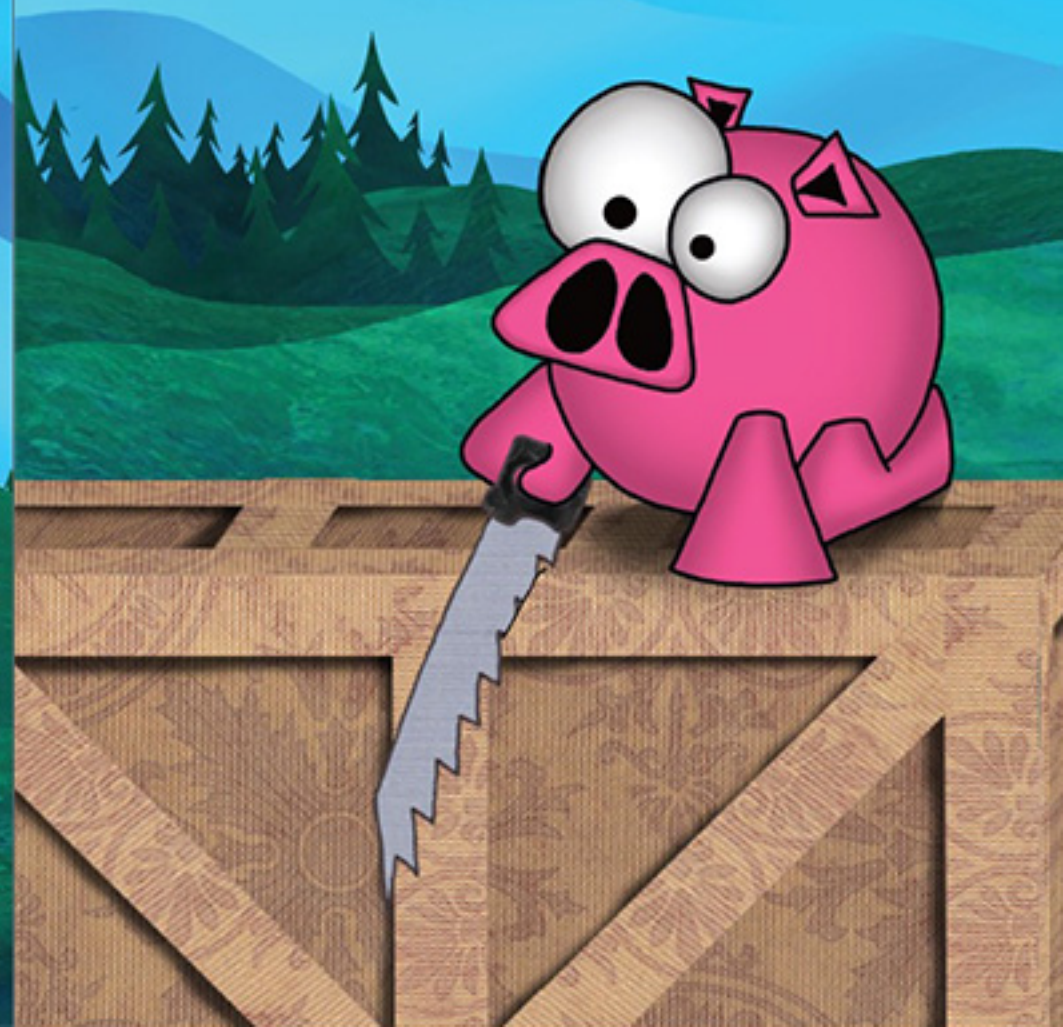
**“One day I will fly too,” said

answered the dragonfly.**

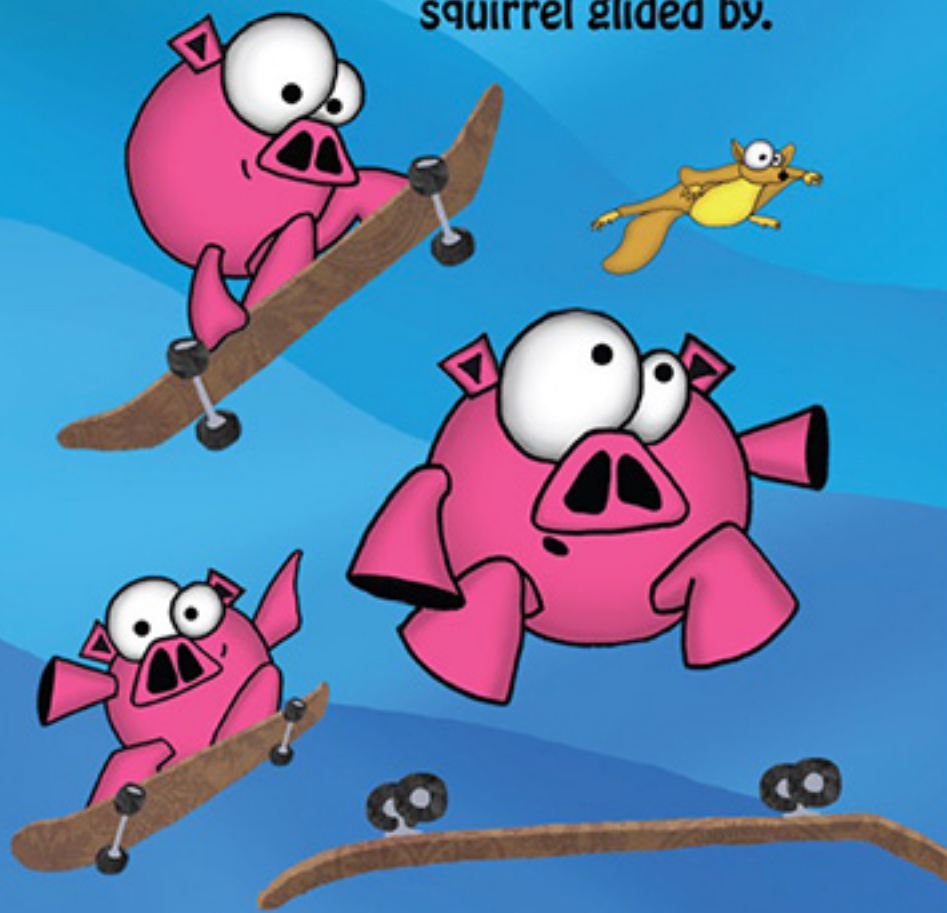
**“Pigs can’t fly! You

squirrel glided by.



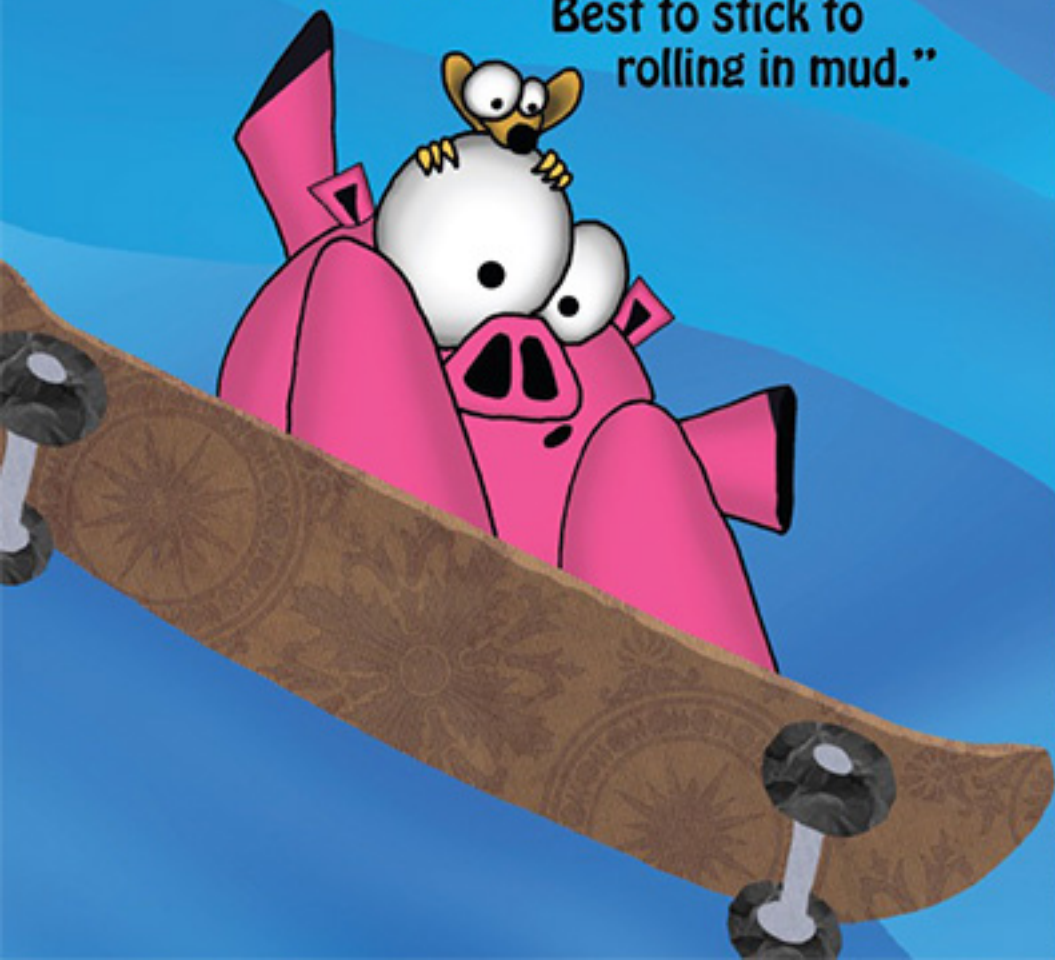
“You fly beautifully,” said the pig.

“One day I will fly too,” said the pig.

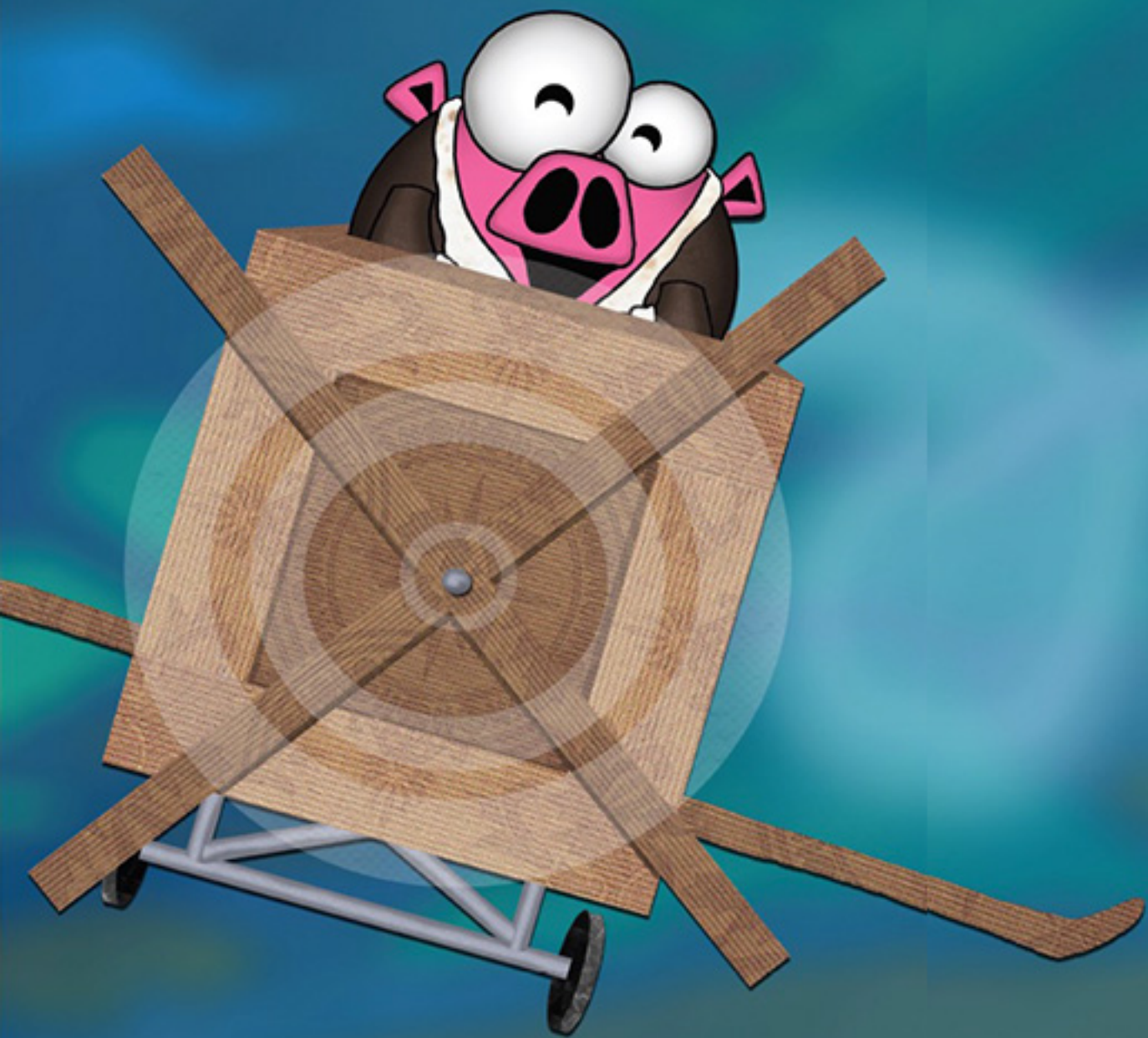
